Expectations:

Your child(ren) should:

 - Goggle rule – Goggles worn over the eyes at all times during a lab; if caught in violation of this rule, the student will be removed from the laboratory and will receive a zero for the lab assignment. It is much easier to recover from a low grade, than it is to regain damaged eyesight!

- Tests and quizzes will be made up during class time.
- Lab make-ups will be on Thursdays after school. The makeup will occur on the first Thursday following the actual lab date.
